

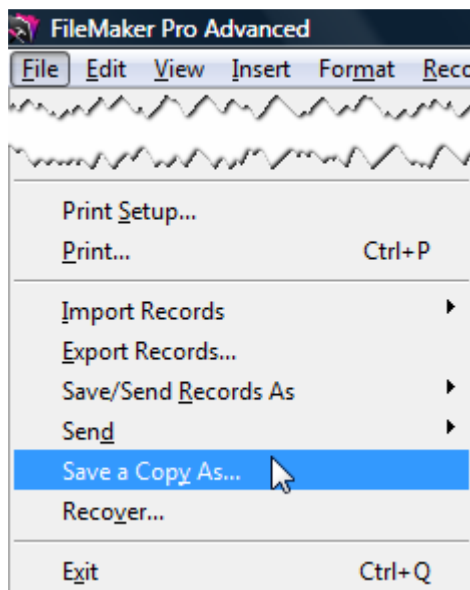
## What is a Clone?

A clone is a copy of a FileMaker Pro file that contains all the field definitions, tables, layouts, scripts, and page setup options, but none of the data.

## How to create a Clone?

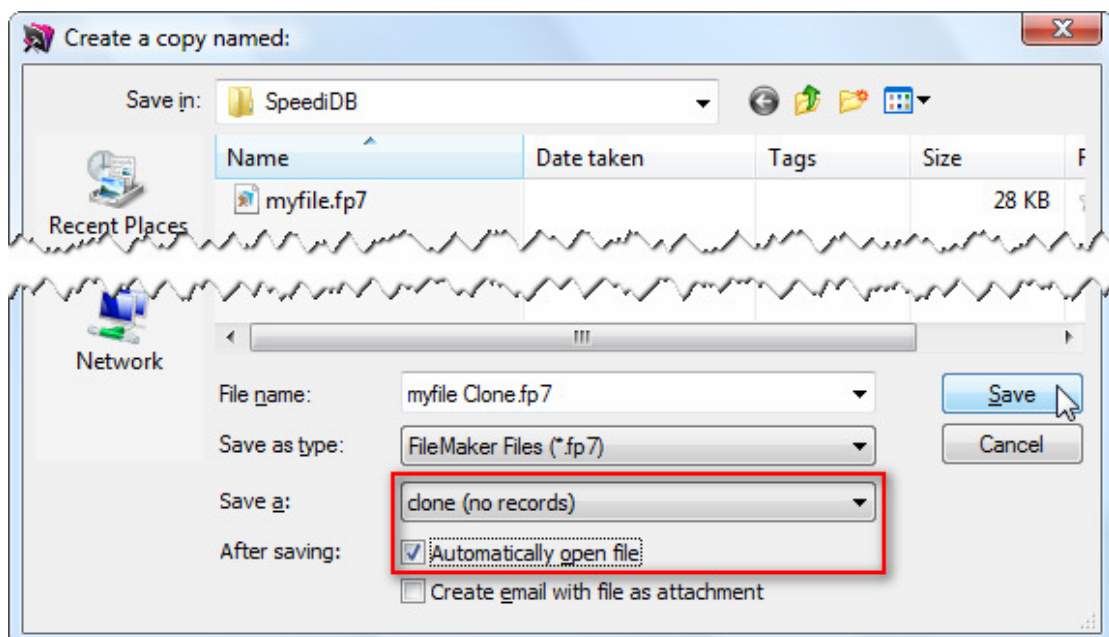
Steps for creating a clone of a FileMaker file, myfile.fp7:

1. Open **myfile.fp7** in FileMaker Pro.
2. Choose **File > Save a Copy As...**



*A dialogue box appears.*

3. Choose **clone (no records)** in **Save a:** drop-down menu.



4. Check **Automatically open file** and click **Save**.  
*FileMaker creates and opens the clone, myfile Clone.fp7.*
5. Check to ensure that **myfile Clone.fp7** has no records and close it.
6. Email **myfile Clone.fp7** to [sales@speedidb.com](mailto:sales@speedidb.com) for analysis.

**Notes:**

1. The steps for creating a Clone are the same for versions \*.fp5, \*.fp7 and \*.fmp12.
2. At the moment, we are only able to analyze \*.fp5 and \*.fp7.
3. We are working on tools to analyze \*.fmp12.
